PUBLIC COMMENT:

- **Shohola Camp:** Two gentlemen representing the general contractor for the Camp came to the Board stating that they are having a problem obtaining a building permit and they need clarification as to what they need to do in order to obtain a permit to complete the construction on the cabins at the Camp.
- **Laurel Muller** representing Shohola Camp spoke to the Supervisors regarding giving the Camp an opportunity to work on temporary septic holding tanks, again, in order to open the camp since their installation of their septic tanks have not been installed yet. Chairman Fluhr advised that they will consult with the SEO on his recommendation.

SUPERVISORS COMMENTS:

- **Vice-Chair Hoeper** – Advised the Board that the railroad ties on Rohman Road were being removed. Mr. Hoeper also advised the Board that the local businesses would like to put an arrow sign on Township property pointing to the local businesses with their names. The question came up about the sign being located in the Upper Delaware Township River corridor. Motion to refer this proposal to Planning Committee, made by Chairman Fluhr, second by Supervisor Raser, motion carried.
- **Vice-Chair Hoeper** made comment that he talked with Municipal Services regarding the cost and advertising on all the dirt roads. The project will have to be approved by the Board.
